



40 Ford Instructions and Registration

The 43rd Annual Mountain Moonshine Festival will be the most exciting year ever because we are featuring our 1940 Fords (as well as other moonshine era cars) in the beauty and elegance they deserve. “OUR” Forties have earned a special place at the moonshine festival by setting us apart from other festivals. This year will be the most memorable ever and we’re glad you’re going to be a part of it.

- You may pre-register by completing the attached form or by visiting our website at www.kareforkids.us. You can mail your form or email it, or fax it to us as early as possible.
- We will accept registrations on Saturday, October 23rd. Please drive your car to the center of town BEFORE 7:30 am and see a KARE for Kids member (in orange vests) to get an assigned space number and permit.
- Spaces will be available on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- There will be NO FEE to register, donations are appreciated.
- All cars parked in town, must be parked BEFORE 8:00 am and remain there until 5:00 pm. The Sheriff’s Dept. and Fire Marshal will not allow vehicles to be moved during festival operating hours.
- The following categories have been established and a corresponding colored permit will be mailed to the pre-registered participants. (Please see the attached map for parking locations for each category).

***Only authentic moonshine-hauling cars will be allowed to park in town. Since a “moonshine-hauling era” car can be difficult to define, please refer to the color-coded numbered spaces below and on the map to determine which spaces are applicable to your car.**

PINK – spaces 1 – 35 – must be a 1939 or 1940 Ford Authentic Moonshine Car

GREEN – spaces 36 – 48 – must be a Pre-1939 Authentic Moonshine Car

YELLOW – spaces 49 - 79 - Pre-1964 Authentic Moonshine Cars

- We are required to leave room for emergency vehicles to travel through town, per Sheriff’s Dept. and Fire Marshal but we feel we will be able to create additional spaces if needed. Please note: the map is subject to change depending on the number of pre-registered cars; however space numbers 1 – 79 will more than likely not change.
- Please DO NOT try to park in town without a registration permit. Everyone that parks in town must have a numbered space and be registered with KARE for Kids.

- All cars that do not fit in the category of being in the moonshine-hauling era will be able to park at the City Municipal Complex or on marked side streets, as space permits.
- The parking spaces you acquire on Saturday will be yours on Sunday as well. Please keep the registration permit, displayed in your window and report directly to your space on Sunday morning. Remember, your car must be in place before 8:00 am and not removed until after 5:00 pm.
