



Peddler's Permit City of Dawsonville Mountain Moonshine Festival October 23 – 24, 2010

The following guidelines and procedures for a Peddlers Permit are applicable to any business, individual or organization that conducts business or service **within the city limits of Dawsonville** during the above mentioned dates and have NOT paid a vendor booth rental fee to participate in the festival activities.

1. Must complete an application.
2. Must submit a letter from the property owner granting permission to the group to conduct any type of business or service.
3. A separate application must be submitted for each business or service as governed by the vendor application process of KARE for Kids, Inc..
4. Permit types and fees are as follows:

Food – Limited \$300 (3 or less food items, not including drinks)

Premium \$600 (more than 3 food items)

**Both food permits require a permit from Dawson County Health Dept.*

Craft/Other - \$175 (includes yard sales)

***Must provide a Certificate of Insurance to KARE for Kids, Inc., minimum of \$1,000,000 liability limits.*

Parking - \$3.00 per car, covered under KARE for Kids, Inc. insurance policy and exempt from providing Certificate of Insurance.

5. Your organization/business must be clearly identified at the business location and a business owner or group leader must be clearly identified in case of complaints or problems.
6. Each employee or volunteer must sign a waiver of liability and will be the responsibility of the permit applicant to obtain.

The following guidelines are in addition to the above and apply to Parking Peddler Permits only:

1. Each of your “parkers” must wear an orange vest for safety reasons.
2. The parking spaces should be large enough for the average vehicle to enter and exit safely. You can not block entrances and exits with empty vehicles.
3. You must to have a clear understanding of the complete traffic route and festival procedures in order to safely fit into this role of traffic control.
4. You will be notified and must attend a mandatory meeting prior to festival, as set by KARE for Kids, Inc.
5. The maximum parking fee must be no more than \$5.00.
6. There must be someone available to monitor the parking area and provide direction during hours of festival operation, which are 8:00 am until 5:00 pm.
7. You must report any violators or violations to either the Dawson County Sheriffs Dept. or KARE for Kids, Inc. This includes, but is not limited to, parking violations, safety violations, improper behavior or suspicious actions from volunteers, staff, or visitors, and illegal activity such as theft, property damage, etc.
